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I change my socks	once twice	a day / week / month / year.
I wash my sports shoes	three times	

How often ...?



How often do you wash your hands?

How often do you brush your teeth?

= **How many times do you do something in a time period**

We ask **How often ...** questions to find out the number of times people do something in a time period.



Talking about frequency



How often do you wash your hands?

I only wash my hands at bedtime.

I wash my hands **once a day**.

= one time each day



Talking about frequency



How often do you brush your teeth?

I brush my teeth on Saturdays and Sundays.

= two times each week



Talking about frequency



How often do you wash your hands?

How often do you brush your teeth?

We use phrases like these to express frequency.

I wash my hands **once a day**.

I brush my teeth **twice a week**.



Talking about habits

- **How often** means 'How many times'. We use **How often** to ask about the number of times a person does something.

e.g. **How often** do you brush your teeth?

= How many times do you brush your teeth?

- We answer **How often** questions by saying the number of times we do something during a time period.

e.g. I brush my teeth **twice a week**.

once a week / four times a month

I brush my teeth every morning and every evening. = I brush my teeth **twice a day**.

I go to the library on Fridays.
= I go to the library **once a week**.

I go swimming on 1st and 15th every month.
= I go swimming **twice a month**.

I go to the dentist in January and August every year. = I go to the dentist **twice a year**.

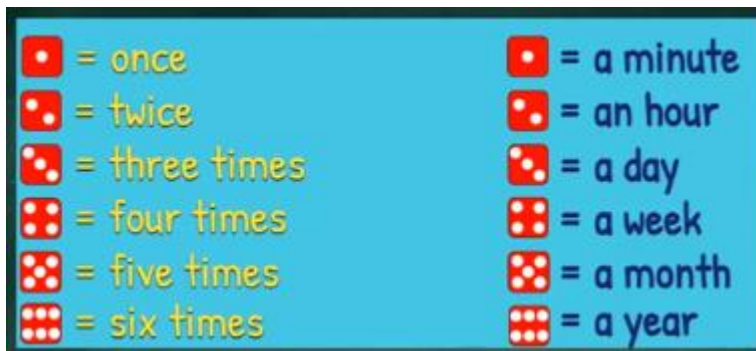
